

Force Volleyball Club Parent Commitment

To our valued parents/guardians,

We ask that you take time to read through the following document and adhere to these standards set out by Force Volleyball Club. Your commitment to these standards will assist us in creating a positive atmosphere in all practices and competition and ultimately, give our athletes a positive club experience.

1. I will remember that ultimately, a positive experience will enable my child to enjoy playing Volleyball and encourage him/her to continue in his/her pursuit of excellence.
2. I will encourage my child to compete fairly and to resolve conflicts using positive resolution techniques and not with hostility I will teach my child that character and integrity are more important than being a skilled athlete.
3. I will encourage healthy eating habits and personal fitness in my child.
4. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.
5. I will encourage my child and offer praise for fair competition and excellent work ethic.
6. I will offer support and encouragement when my child does not compete to the best of his/her ability. I understand that expressing disappointment in my child's performance independent of effort is not in their best interest. I will cheer FOR my child and never against another child.
7. I will remember that I am an example to my child. I will applaud good performances and show respect to all players, officials and other parents.
8. I will respect the officials, even when I do not agree with them. I understand that negative treatment of officials will not be tolerated.
9. I understand that coaching from the sidelines or undermining a coach is not acceptable.
10. I will respect my child's coach(es) and show appreciation for their hard work and time. At home, I will always speak positively of the coach and if I have a concern, I will bring it to the attention of the coach personally.
11. Should a conflict arise, I will wait a 24 hour period before approaching a coach IN PERSON to discuss it. I will not approach a coach in anger, or express my concerns via email.

12. Should a conflict remain unresolved following a discussion with the coach, I will contact the club director to assist in resolving the issue.
13. I understand that should I not adhere to the above policies, or should my son/daughter not adhere to player policies, then he/she may be removed from a team at the discretion of the coach and club director.
